
HOUSE BILL No. 1190

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-10-8-11

Synopsis: Prescription drugs for retired state employees. Requires the state to offer coverage for prescription drugs to retired state employees who are not wholly covered for prescription drugs under another plan of assistance or insurance.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1190



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-10-8-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 2000]: **Sec. 11. (a) As used in this section, "prescription drug**
- 4 **plan" means a:**
- 5 (1) **self-insurance program established under section 7(b) of**
- 6 **this chapter; or**
- 7 (2) **contract for services through a prepaid health care**
- 8 **delivery plan entered into under section 7(c) of this chapter;**
- 9 **by the state to provide coverage for prescription drugs.**
- 10 (b) **As used in this section, "prescription drugs" means all**
- 11 **legend drugs (as defined in IC 16-18-2-199), including the**
- 12 **following:**
- 13 (1) **Any interchangeable drug products, including generic**
- 14 **drug products.**
- 15 (2) **Diabetic testing materials.**
- 16 (3) **Insulin, insulin syringes, and insulin needles.**
- 17 (c) **The state shall offer coverage under a prescription drug plan**



1 to retired state employees who are not wholly covered for
2 prescription drugs under another plan of assistance or insurance.

3 (d) A retired state employee who participates in a prescription
4 drug plan offered under subsection (c) shall pay one-half (1/2) of
5 the cost of the premium, and the state shall pay one-half (1/2) of the
6 cost of the premium.

7 (e) Eligibility for Medicare under 42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq. does not
8 disqualify a retired state employee from eligibility for coverage
9 under a prescription drug plan offered under subsection (c).

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
