

HOUSE BILL No. 1341

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-1-30-3.

Synopsis: Primetime participation. Provides that the 113% ceiling on changes in primetime distributions from 1999 to 2000 does not apply to the Crothersville school corporation, which did not participate in primetime in 1999.

Effective: January 1, 2000 (retroactive).

HOUSE BILL No. 1341



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education finance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 21-1-30-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.3-2000,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JANUARY 1, 2000 (RETROACTIVE)]: Sec. 3. (a) The amount to be
4 distributed to a school corporation under this chapter is the amount
5 determined by the following formula:

6 STEP ONE: Determine the applicable target pupil teacher ratio
7 for the school corporation as follows:

8 (A) If the school corporation's at-risk index is less than
9 seventeen hundredths (0.17), the school corporation's target
10 pupil teacher ratio is eighteen to one (18:1).

11 (B) If the school corporation's at-risk index is at least
12 seventeen hundredths (0.17) but less than twenty-seven
13 hundredths (0.27), the school corporation's target pupil teacher
14 ratio is fifteen (15) plus the result of:

15 (i) determine the result of twenty-seven hundredths (0.27)
16 minus the school corporation's at-risk index;

17 (ii) determine the item (i) result divided by one-tenth (0.1);

- 2 (iii) determine the item (ii) result multiplied by three (3).
- 3 (C) If the school corporation's at-risk index is at least
- 4 twenty-seven hundredths (0.27), the school corporation's target
- 5 pupil teacher ratio is fifteen to one (15:1).
- 6 **STEP TWO:** Determine the result of:
- 7 (A) the ADM of the school corporation, as determined under
- 8 section 2(2) of this chapter, in kindergarten through grade 3
- 9 for the current school year; divided by
- 10 (B) the school corporation's target pupil teacher ratio, as
- 11 determined in STEP ONE.
- 12 **STEP THREE:** Determine the result of:
- 13 (A) the total regular general fund revenue (the amount
- 14 determined in STEP ONE of IC 21-3-1.7-8) multiplied by
- 15 seventy-five hundredths (0.75); divided by
- 16 (B) the school corporation's total ADM.
- 17 **STEP FOUR:** Determine the result of:
- 18 (A) the STEP THREE result; multiplied by
- 19 (B) the ADM of the school corporation, as determined under
- 20 section 2(2) of this chapter in kindergarten through grade 3 for
- 21 the current school year.
- 22 **STEP FIVE:** Determine the result of:
- 23 (A) the STEP FOUR result; divided by
- 24 (B) the staff cost amount.
- 25 **STEP SIX:** Determine the greater of zero (0) or the result of:
- 26 (A) the STEP TWO amount; minus
- 27 (B) the STEP FIVE amount.
- 28 **STEP SEVEN:** Determine the result of:
- 29 (A) the STEP SIX amount; multiplied by
- 30 (B) the staff cost amount.
- 31 **STEP EIGHT:** Determine the greater of the STEP SEVEN amount
- 32 or the school corporation's guaranteed amount.
- 33 **STEP NINE:** Determine the lesser of:
- 34 (A) the STEP EIGHT amount; or
- 35 (B) the amount the school corporation received under this
- 36 chapter for the previous calendar year multiplied by one
- 37 hundred thirteen percent (113%).
- 38 For 2000 calculations, the amount the school corporation received
- 39 under this chapter for the previous calendar year is the 1999
- 40 calendar year allocation, before any penalty was assessed under
- 41 this chapter. **For a school corporation that did not receive a**
- 42 **distribution under this chapter for 1999 and that is located in**

1 **a county having a population of more than thirty-seven**
 2 **thousand (37,000) but less than thirty-seven thousand eight**
 3 **hundred (37,800), the STEP EIGHT amount is the school**
 4 **corporation's distribution amount.**

5 (b) The amount received under this chapter shall be devoted to
 6 reducing class size in kindergarten through grade 3. A school
 7 corporation shall compile class size data for kindergarten through grade
 8 3 and report the data to the department of education for purposes of
 9 maintaining compliance with this chapter.

10 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2000 (RETROACTIVE)]

11 **This act applies to primetime distributions for 2000 and thereafter.**

12 SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
