

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 331 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, after line 14, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 2. IC 14-22-12-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
4 1, 2000]: **Sec. 1.5. (a) As used in this section, "qualified individual"**
5 **means an individual who:**
6 **(1) is a resident of Indiana;**
7 **(2) has served in the armed forces of the United States; and**
8 **(3) has more than a ten percent (10%) service connected**
9 **disability as evidenced by:**
10 **(A) records of the United States Department of Veterans**
11 **Affairs; or**
12 **(B) disability retirement benefits awarded to the**
13 **individual under laws administered by the United States**
14 **Department of Defense.**
15 **(b) A qualified individual is entitled to hunting and fishing**
16 **licenses under this section without charge.**
17 **(c) Each year a qualified individual may obtain:**
18 **(1) both:**
19 **(A) a resident yearly license to fish; and**
20 **(B) a resident yearly license to hunt; or**
21 **(2) a resident yearly license to hunt and fish;**
22 **without charge,**
23 **(d) An applicant for a no-charge license under this section**
24 **must do the following:**
25 **(1) Request the license from:**
26 **(A) the department;**
27 **(B) an agent appointed by the director under**
28 **IC 14-22-11-3; or**
29 **(C) the clerk of the circuit court who is an authorized**
30 **representative of the department under IC 14-22-11-3 in**
31 **the county in which the individual resides.**
32 **(2) Present evidence that the applicant is a qualified**

individual."
