

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 468 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 8, delete lines 15 through 29, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 **"Sec. 4. Each individual who teaches in a charter school must**
4 **hold a license to teach in a public school."**
5 Page 12, line 16, delete "or the professional standards board
6 (established by" and insert ".".
7 Page 12, delete line 17, begin a new line single block indented and
8 insert:
9 **"(3) A rule or guideline adopted by the professional standards**
10 **board (established by IC 20-1-1.4-2), except for those rules**
11 **that assist a teacher in gaining or renewing a standard or**
12 **advanced license."**
13 Page 12, line 18, delete "(3)" and insert "(4)".
14 Page 14, line 31, after "IC 20-5.5-3" insert **"to the governing body**
15 **of the school corporation in which an existing elementary or**
16 **secondary school is located"**.
17 Page 14, line 32, delete "an" and insert **"the"**.
18 Page 14, between lines 32 and 33, begin a new paragraph and insert:
19 **"Sec. 4. Only the governing body of the school corporation in**
20 **which an existing public elementary or secondary school that seeks**
21 **conversion to a charter school is located may act as the sponsor of**
22 **the conversion charter school."**
23 Page 14, line 33, delete "4." and insert **"5."**.
24 Page 17, line 23, delete "full time" and insert "full-time".
25 Page 19, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
26 **"SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a)**
27 **Notwithstanding IC 20-5.5-6-4, as added by this act, until the end**
28 **of the school year in which the professional standards board**
29 **(established by IC 20-1-1.4-2) implements an alternative method of**
30 **beginning teacher licensure, the following apply to teachers in a**

- 1 **charter school:**
- 2 **(1) A teacher must have a four (4) year college degree from an**
- 3 **accredited institution.**
- 4 **(2) At least seventy-five percent (75%) of the teachers in a**
- 5 **charter school must hold a license to teach in a public school.**
- 6 **(3) Not more than twenty-five percent (25%) of a charter**
- 7 **school's teaching staff may be individuals who:**
- 8 **(A) are not licensed to teach in a public school; and**
- 9 **(B) possess specific knowledge or skills that are critical to**
- 10 **the mission of the charter school.**
- 11 **(4) A charter school teacher described in subdivision (3) is**
- 12 **subject to:**
- 13 **(A) regular performance reviews; and**
- 14 **(B) professional development activities;**
- 15 **as determined and identified by the organizer.**
- 16 **(b) This SECTION expires June 30, 2005."**
- 17 **Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.**
