

# SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

**I move** that Senate Bill 468 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, delete lines 28 through 29.
- 2 Page 4, delete lines 14 through 24.
- 3 Page 4, line 25, delete "(b)" and insert "**Sec. 4. (a)**".
- 4 Page 5, line 5, delete "(c)" and insert "**(b)**".
- 5 Page 8, delete lines 15 through 29, begin a new paragraph and
- 6 insert:
- 7 "**Sec. 4. Each individual who teaches in a charter school must**
- 8 **hold a license to teach in a public school.**".
- 9 Page 12, line 16, delete "or the professional standards board
- 10 (established by" and insert ".".
- 11 Page 12, delete line 17, begin a new line single block indented and
- 12 insert:
- 13 "**(3) A rule or guideline adopted by the professional standards**
- 14 **board (established by IC 20-1-1.4-2), except for those rules**
- 15 **that assist a teacher in gaining or renewing a standard or**
- 16 **advanced license.**".
- 17 Page 12, line 18, delete "(3)" and insert "**(4)**".
- 18 Page 14, line 31, after "IC 20-5.5-3" insert "**to the governing body**
- 19 **of the school corporation in which an existing elementary or**
- 20 **secondary school is located**".
- 21 Page 14, line 32, delete "an" and insert "**the**".
- 22 Page 14, between lines 32 and 33, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 23 "**Sec. 4. Only the governing body of the school corporation in**
- 24 **which an existing public elementary or secondary school that seeks**
- 25 **conversion to a charter school is located may act as the sponsor of**
- 26 **the conversion charter school.**".
- 27 Page 14, line 33, delete "4." and insert "**5.**".
- 28 Page 17, line 23, delete "full time" and insert "full-time".
- 29 Page 19, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 30 "**SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a)**

1       **Notwithstanding IC 20-5.5-6-4, as added by this act, until the end**  
 2       **of the school year in which the professional standards board**  
 3       **(established by IC 20-1-1.4-2) implements an alternative method of**  
 4       **beginning teacher licensure, the following apply to teachers in a**  
 5       **charter school:**

- 6               **(1) A teacher must have a four (4) year college degree from an**  
 7               **accredited institution.**  
 8               **(2) At least seventy-five percent (75%) of the teachers in a**  
 9               **charter school must hold a license to teach in a public school.**  
 10              **(3) Not more than twenty-five percent (25%) of a charter**  
 11              **school's teaching staff may be individuals who:**  
 12                      **(A) are not licensed to teach in a public school; and**  
 13                      **(B) possess specific knowledge or skills that are critical to**  
 14                      **the mission of the charter school.**  
 15              **(4) A charter school teacher described in subdivision (3) is**  
 16              **subject to:**  
 17                      **(A) regular performance reviews; and**  
 18                      **(B) professional development activities;**  
 19                      **as determined and identified by the organizer.**  
 20              **(b) This SECTION expires June 30, 2005."**  
 21       Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.  
       (Reference is to SB 468 as printed January 28, 2000.)
