## SENATE BILL No. 41

---

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 33-5-25.3-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 5. (a) The judge of the  
3 court shall appoint a bailiff and an official court reporter for the court.  
4 (b) **The court may appoint a referee and other personnel as the**  
5 **court determines necessary to facilitate and transact the business**  
6 **of the court.**  
7 (c) ~~Their~~ **Salaries of the personnel described in subsections (a)**  
8 **and (b)** shall be fixed in the same manner as the salaries of the bailiff  
9 and official court reporter for the Huntington circuit court. Their  
10 salaries shall be paid ~~monthly~~ out of the treasury of Huntington County  
11 as provided by law.
