DIGEST OF SB 63 (Updated January 20, 2000 11:01 AM - DI 73)

Citations Affected: IC 5-10.1.

Synopsis: Social Security coverage of certain students. Allows the state to amend the federal-state agreement concerning Social Security coverage of public employees to exclude from coverage any service performed after June 30, 2000, in the employ of a school, college, or university if the service is performed by a student who is enrolled and regularly attending classes at the school, college, or university. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the pension management oversight commission.)

Effective: Upon passage.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. SENATE BILL No. 63

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-10.1-2-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 9. The state agency and a school, college,**
4 **or university may amend the agreement to exclude from coverage**
5 **under the federal Social Security Act any service performed after**
6 **June 30, 2000, in the employ of the school, college, or university if**
7 **the service is performed by a student who is enrolled and regularly**
8 **attending classes at the school, college, or university.**

9 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
