Effective: July 1, 2000.

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1999 General Assembly.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state police, civil defense and military affairs and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated to the World War II Memorial Campaign four**
3 **hundred fourteen thousand dollars (\$414,000) from the state**
4 **general fund to be used for the National World War II Memorial**
5 **authorized by United States Public Law 103-32 for the period**
6 **beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.**
7 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2001.**
