Synopsis: Distribution of enrolled acts. Allows the legislative services agency to fulfill its responsibility to distribute the enrolled acts by distributing the acts in the form of a hard paper copy or in the form of an electronic copy. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the code revision commission.)

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 90

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 2-6-1.5-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5. Not more than
3 fourteen (14) days (including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays)
4 after the last day the governor must take action on enrolled acts passed
5 during any session of the general assembly, the legislative services
6 agency shall distribute to the clerk of the circuit court of each county
7 one (1) copy of each enrolled act of that session which became law.
8 **The copy distributed may be in the form of a hard paper copy or**
9 **an electronic copy on a computer disk, on a CD-ROM disk, or in**
10 **another machine readable format.** This distribution shall be
11 delivered by certified mail, or by any other means of delivery that
12 includes a return receipt, to each of the clerks of the counties of the
13 state, and shall fulfill the publication and circulation requirements of
14 Art. 4, Sec. 28 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.
15 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
