Citations Affected: IC 16-21.

Synopsis: Hospital council. Requires the appointment to the hospital council of an additional member who is engaged in administering ambulatory outpatient surgical centers.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

SENATE BILL No. 318

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-21-1-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 1. (a) The hospital
3 council is created.
4 (b) The council consists of ~~eight (8)~~ **nine (9)** members appointed by
5 the governor as follows:
6 (1) One (1) must be a licensed physician.
7 (2) One (1) must be a registered nurse licensed under IC 25-23
8 and experienced in providing acute care services.
9 (3) Three (3) must be ~~persons~~ **individuals** engaged in hospital
10 administration.
11 (4) **One (1) must be an individual engaged in ambulatory**
12 **outpatient surgical center administration.**
13 (5) One (1) must be ~~appointed by the governor~~ from the division
14 of family and children.
15 ~~(5) (6)~~ (6) One (1) must be the state health commissioner.
16 ~~(6) (7)~~ (7) One (1) must be an individual who is not associated with
17 hospitals, except as a consumer.

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1 (c) Except for the members of the council appointed under
2 subsection (b)(3), a member of the council may not have a pecuniary
3 interest in the operation of, or provide professional services through
4 employment or under contract to, an institution or agency licensed
5 under this article.
