Citations Affected: IC 14-30.

Synopsis: St. Joseph River basin commission. Allows a county council member to receive a copy of the St. Joseph river basin commission's annual report. Allows the St. Joseph river basin commission to adopt a resolution designating an officer or member of the commission to handle money belonging to the commission.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

SENATE BILL No. 448

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 14-30-3-18 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 18. The commission
3 shall make an annual report of the commission's activities to the
4 executive of each participating county. The commission shall upon
5 request make an annual report to the following:

- 6 (1) The governor.
7 (2) Any member of the general assembly.
8 **(3) Any member of the county council of a participating**
9 **county.**

10 SECTION 2. IC 14-30-3-25 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
11 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 25. (a) The commission
12 shall make expenditures only as budgeted. However, the commission
13 may revise the budget at any time to authorize unbudgeted
14 expenditures.

15 (b) Any appropriated amounts remaining unexpended or
16 unencumbered at the end of the fiscal year become part of a
17 nonreverting cumulative fund to be held in the name of the

1 commission. The commission may authorize unbudgeted expenditures
2 from this fund.
3 (c) The commission is responsible for the safekeeping and deposit
4 of money the commission receives under this chapter. The state board
5 of accounts shall:
6 (1) prescribe the methods and forms for keeping; and
7 (2) periodically audit;
8 the accounts, records, and books of the commission.
9 (d) The treasurer of the commission **or another officer or member**
10 **of the commission designated by a resolution of the commission**
11 may receive, disburse, and handle money belonging to the commission,
12 subject to the following:
13 (1) Applicable statutes.
14 (2) Procedures established by the commission.
