

**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT
DIGEST FOR ESB 489**

Citations Affected: IC 21-3; noncode.

Synopsis: School funding. Increases the tuition support cap for calendar year 2000. Provides that in determining average daily membership, beginning with 2001 funding, an eligible pupil who is enrolled in a public school and in a nonpublic school shall be counted on a full-time equivalency basis with a 5% add-on. Phases in the impact of this change over three years. Provides that this change does not apply to the calculation of 2000 tuition support, at-risk distributions, or 2000 primetime distributions. Provides that these pupils are not considered in the calculation of a school corporation's enrollment adjustment grant. Provides that the definition of "eligible pupil" includes certain students who are placed in a facility located in a transferee school corporation's attendance area by a parent or guardian. (This conference committee report provides that days of enrollment are used to determine FTE, provides a 5% FTE add-on, phases in the loss of ADM over three years, and deletes the house amendments.)

Effective: January 1, 2000 (retroactive); July 1, 2000; January 1, 2001.
