

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred House Bill No. 1197, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 6 and 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "**(c) The select joint committee on Medicaid oversight**
3 **established by this act must review and, not later than September**
4 **1, 2000, determine whether to disapprove the proposals described**
5 **in this SECTION. If the select joint committee on Medicaid**
6 **oversight votes to disapprove the proposals, the office of the**
7 **secretary of family and social services may not submit the**
8 **proposals to the federal Health Care Financing Administration.**
9 **(d) The office of the secretary of family and social services must**
10 **receive input from affected providers and consumers when**
11 **drafting the language of applications for Medicaid waivers**
12 **described in this SECTION."**
13 Page 2, line 7, delete "(c)" and insert "(e)".
14 Page 2, line 11, delete "(d)" and insert "(f)".
15 Page 2, line 14, delete "(e)" and insert "(g)".
16 Page 2, line 15, after "governor," insert "**the select joint committee**
17 **on Medicaid oversight,"**.
18 Page 2, between lines 17 and 18, begin a new paragraph and insert:
19 "**(h) This SECTION expires January 1, 2002.**
20 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2000 (RETROACTIVE)]

1 (a) As used in this SECTION, "committee" refers to the select joint
2 committee on Medicaid oversight established by this SECTION.

3 (b) As used in this SECTION, "office" refers to the office of
4 Medicaid policy and planning.

5 (c) The select joint committee on Medicaid oversight is
6 established.

7 (d) The committee consists of twelve (12) voting members
8 appointed as follows:

9 (1) Six (6) members shall be appointed from the senate by the
10 president pro tempore of the senate, not more than three (3)
11 of whom may be from the same political party.

12 (2) Six (6) members shall be appointed from the house of
13 representatives by the speaker of the house of representatives,
14 not more than three (3) of whom may be from the same
15 political party.

16 (e) A vacancy on the committee shall be filled by the appointing
17 authority.

18 (f) The president pro tempore of the senate shall appoint a
19 member of the committee to serve as chairperson of the committee
20 from January 1, 2000, until December 31, 2000.

21 (g) The speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint a
22 member of the committee to serve as chairperson of the committee
23 from January 1, 2001, until December 31, 2001.

24 (h) The committee shall study, investigate, and oversee the
25 following:

26 (1) Whether the contractor of the office under IC 12-15-30
27 that has responsibility for processing provider claims for
28 payment under the Medicaid program has properly
29 performed the terms of the contractor's contract with the
30 state.

31 (2) Legislative and administrative procedures that are needed
32 to eliminate Medicaid claims, reimbursement backlogs,
33 delays, and errors.

34 (3) The implementation of a case mix reimbursement system
35 designed for Indiana Medicaid certified nursing facilities
36 developed by the office.

37 (4) Any other matter related to Medicaid.

38 (i) Except as otherwise provided under this subsection, the

1 **committee is under the jurisdiction of the legislative council. The**
2 **committee:**

- 3 (1) shall meet at the call of the chairperson;
- 4 (2) may meet at any time during the calendar year; and
- 5 (3) shall be staffed by the legislative services agency.

6 (j) **The contractor of the office under IC 12-15-30 that has**
7 **responsibility for processing provider claims for payment under**
8 **the Medicaid program shall:**

- 9 (1) review actual expenditures of the Medicaid program based
- 10 on claims that are processed by the contractor; and
- 11 (2) provide oral and written reports on the expenditures to the
- 12 committee:

13 (A) in a manner and format proposed by the committee;

14 **and**
15 (B) whenever requested by the committee.

16 (k) **This SECTION expires December 31, 2001."**

17 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
