A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION congratulating and honoring Steven C. Beering on his tenure and accomplishments as President of Purdue University.

Whereas, The State of Indiana takes great pride in the accomplishments of its higher education institutions;

Whereas, Purdue University has attained new heights of excellence and achievement during the seventeen-year tenure of President Steven C. Beering;

Whereas, during that time, Dr. Beering has been a pre-eminent leader and advocate for higher education institutions in Indiana and the nation;

Whereas, the University has benefited greatly by the high ideals, inspired vision, and steadfast sense of mission that have marked Dr. Beering's tenure;

Whereas, the University's significant attainments in educational and research excellence, lifelong learning, enrollment growth, internationalization, state economic-development initiatives, and campus beautification have occurred during Dr. Beering's time in the presidency;

Whereas, The University's traditional land-grant goals of education, research, and service have been profoundly enhanced through Dr. Beering's leadership and commitment;

Whereas, as a lasting legacy of that leadership and commitment, Purdue undoubtedly will maintain its vital role in the twenty-first



century in service to the state, the nation, and the world;

Whereas, Dr. Beering plans to relinquish the presidency on July 1, 2000: Therefore,

- 5 Education in a career in the Hoosier State spanning more than thirty
- 6 years.

- 9 Purdue University Board of Trustees and the Chairperson of the
- 10 University Senate for their permanent records.
