Whereas, Dr. Jack Gren, Fort Wayne, Indiana, is a speaker, educator, and author and a consultant to business, industry, and professional organizations nationwide;

Whereas, Dr. Jack Gren is also a patriotic American;

Whereas, Dr. Jack Gren has received the George Washington Honor Medal for Excellence for his moving tribute to the veterans of World War II, "Who are the Veterans of World War Two";

Whereas, The national awards program was created to salute the exceptional efforts of individuals and organizations who promote, through words and deeds, an understanding of responsible citizenship and the American way of life;

Whereas, His tribute has been designated a national salute to all World War II veterans by the Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge;

Whereas, As a teenager, Dr. Gren served in the Air Force and flew the "Hump" in the China-Burma-India theater during World War II; and

Whereas, Because of the actions of patriotic Americans



like Dr. Gren, the sacrifices endured by the men and women who served their country during time of war will never be forgotten: Therefore,
