Whereas, Kandy Brown has been a teacher in the Indianapolis Public School system for 20 years, 14 of those at Arsenal Technical High School;

Whereas, Kandy Brown is the director of the "New Age Harmony" barbershop quartet that on Saturday, February 5th 2000, was awarded first place at the Prelude Awards in the collaboration category, and Kandy Brown was presented with the Outstanding Arts Educator Award;

Whereas, Kandy Brown has directed the Techoir (a classical concert choir) at the Earlham College High School Choral Invitational in Richmond, Indiana, and the Harmonettes, a girl barbershop quartet that placed third last summer in the International Young Women harmony Rising Star Competition in San Antonio, Texas.;

Whereas, Kandy Brown was the music director, bell choir director, and organist at Beech Grove United Methodist Church for 15 years;

Whereas, Kandy Brown has been involved with her two musically

talented sons in a bluegrass band performing at festivals around the Midwest;

Whereas, Kandy Brown is a clinician for the Beech Grove Choral Camp and has conducted several bell choir workshops around the area;

Whereas, Kandy Brown sang for five years with Mon Choer, the resident vocal chamber ensemble at the University of Indianapolis, and has traveled with the University Choir and Festival Choral in the United States and Europe.
