SENATE RESOLUTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

A SENATE RESOLUTION to memorialize Charles "Chuck" Jefferis for his lifetime of community service to Union City, Indiana.

Whereas, the Indiana Senate mourns the loss of Charles "Chuck" Jefferis, Union City, Indiana mayor and exemplary civic leader, who passed away on January 18, 2000;

Whereas, Chuck provided distinguished service to this great nation while serving in the United States Army during the Korean War;

Whereas, Chuck was an active leader in Union City's local government, serving on the city council for 4 years as president of the council, mayor pro-tem, and most recently as its newly-elected mayor;

Whereas, Chuck was heavily involved in Union City's civic affairs, including long-standing service as parade chairman and flea market chairman of the Farmer-Merchant Days celebration, and as general chairman of the Union City Sesquicentennial Committee to celebrate the city's 150th birthday in 1999;

Whereas, active locally in the Boy Scouts of America, Chuck, a former Eagle Scout, was a scoutmaster of a local troop for 15 years, and recipient of various distinguished awards including the Order of the Arrow Vigil honor, the district Award of Merit, and the national Silver Beaver award;

Whereas, Chuck was also involved in other civic activities including the Union City Jaycees, the Chamber of Commerce, and the Rotary, Elks, and Eagles clubs; and

Whereas, Chuck Jefferis will be remembered with high esteem and great regard as a dedicated, hard working, and caring member of the Union City community: Therefore,
