**IMPACT:** State & Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill changes the method in which jury pools are selected to make the list of persons in a county who are at least 18 years of age and who hold a valid license issued by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) the primary source of names for the jury pool. It requires the BMV to provide the list to each county.

**Effective Date:** December 2, 2001.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The BMV reports that they currently provide the lists required in this proposal to two counties: Lake County and Vanderburgh County. Providing this list to the other 90 counties will involve modifying the BMV computer system to accommodate the inclusion of the additional county names for this purpose.

**Explanation of State Revenues:** The BMV reports that while they provide the names to Lake County and Vanderburgh County on an irregular basis, they do not charge the counties. IC 9-29-3-19 allows the BMV to adopt rules to impose or change service charges. For this proposal, the BMV will need to determine a charge consistent with the development of the new list and charge the courts accordingly. The fund affected is the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the BMV.
