# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1729 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 9. IC 4-31-3-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2001]: Sec. 9. The commission
- 5 may:
- 6 (1) adopt rules under IC 4-22-2, including emergency rules under
- 7 IC 4-22-2-37.1, to implement this article, including rules that
- 8 prescribe:
- 9 (A) the forms of wagering that are permitted;
- 10 (B) the number of races;
- 11 (C) the procedures for wagering;
- 12 (D) the wagering information to be provided to the public;
- 13 **(E) the hours in which a racetrack or satellite facility may**
- 14 **sell pari-mutuel pull tabs under IC 4-31-7.5;**
- 15 ~~(F)~~ **(F)** fees for the issuance and renewal of:
- 16 (i) permits under IC 4-31-5;
- 17 (ii) satellite facility licenses under IC 4-31-5.5; and
- 18 (iii) licenses for racetrack personnel and racing participants
- 19 under IC 4-31-6;
- 20 ~~(G)~~ **(G)** investigative fees;
- 21 ~~(H)~~ **(H)** fines and penalties; and
- 22 ~~(I)~~ **(I)** any other regulation that the commission determines is
- 23 in the public interest in the conduct of recognized meetings
- 24 and wagering on horse racing in Indiana;

1 (2) appoint employees in the manner provided by IC 4-15-2 and  
 2 fix their compensation, subject to the approval of the budget  
 3 agency under IC 4-12-1-13;  
 4 (3) enter into contracts necessary to implement this article; and  
 5 (4) receive and consider recommendations from an advisory  
 6 development committee established under IC 4-31-11."  
 7 Page 3, between lines 25 and 26, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
 8 "SECTION 3. IC 4-33-4-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
 9 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
 10 1, 2001]: **Sec. 22. The commission may determine a riverboat's**  
 11 **schedule, including the hours in which gambling games may be**  
 12 **conducted within a reporting period."**  
 13 Page 11, delete lines 22 through 29.  
 14 Page 17, delete lines 17 through 42.  
 15 Page 18, delete lines 1 through 17, begin a new paragraph and  
 16 insert:  
 17 "**Sec. 1. A gaming facility licensed under this article and not**  
 18 **under the jurisdiction of the United States Coast Guard must**  
 19 **comply with the safety requirements adopted by the commission.**  
 20 **The commission shall consult with all applicable state and federal**  
 21 **agencies to ensure compliance with standards for safety, design,**  
 22 **construction, inspection, survey, and the moorings of a**  
 23 **permanently or continuously moored vessel.**  
 24 **Sec. 2. The gaming commission may adopt additional safety**  
 25 **requirements to promote the safety of persons entering a gaming**  
 26 **facility.**  
 27 **Sec. 3. A licensee may not conduct gaming at a facility until all**  
 28 **applicable standards have been met and the commission approves**  
 29 **gaming at the facility."**  
 30 Page 18, line 18, delete "3." and insert "4."  
 31 Page 18, line 18, delete "before".  
 32 Page 18, line 19, delete "licensure and".  
 33 Page 18, line 19, delete "thereafter by a regulatory and review" and  
 34 insert "**to determine the riverboat's continuing compliance with the**  
 35 **safety requirements adopted by the commission."**

36 Page 18, delete lines 20 through 21.  
 37 Page 18, delete lines 28 through 31.  
 38 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
