DIGEST OF HB 1561 (Updated February 27, 2001 10:51 AM - DI 97)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Experience requirements for real estate appraisers. Requires the real estate appraiser licensure and certification board to review the hour value of appraisal work that qualifies for experience credit for licensure or certification of real estate appraisers. Specifies that the review must specifically address the hour value of agricultural appraisal work. Provides rule making authority to establish the hour value of agricultural appraisal work.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1561

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The real estate**
2 **appraiser licensure and certification board created under**
3 **IC 25-34.1-8-1 shall review the hour value of appraisal work that**
4 **qualifies for experience credit for licensure or certification of real**
5 **estate appraisers. The review required under this subdivision must**
6 **specifically address the hour value of agricultural appraisal work**
7 **that qualifies for experience credit.**
8 (b) **The real estate appraiser licensure and certification board**
9 **shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2, including emergency rules under**
10 **IC 4-22-2-37.1, to establish the hour value of agricultural appraisal**
11 **work that qualifies for experience credit for licensure or**
12 **certification of real estate appraisers.**
13 (c) **Emergency rules adopted under this SECTION are effective**
14 **when filed with the secretary of state and expire on the earlier of**
15 **the following:**
16 (1) **The date that the real estate appraiser licensure and**
17 **certification board adopts a permanent rule under IC 4-22-2**

1 **to amend, repeal, or otherwise supersede the previously**
2 **adopted emergency rule.**
3 **(2) June 30, 2003.**
4 **(d) This SECTION expires June 30, 2004.**
