DIGEST OF HB 1049 (Updated February 14, 2002 9:34 AM - DI 104)

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-18; IC 16-19; IC 16-46.

**Synopsis:** Bone marrow and organ donor fees. Establishes a fund to pay for the testing of bone and organ marrow donors. Transfers \$50,000 to the fund from the anatomical gift promotion fund for the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002. Appropriates \$60,650 from the anatomical gift promotion fund for payment for testing of bone marrow before entrance into the National Bone Marrow Registry for the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002.

## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1049

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-18-2-143, AS AMENDED BY P.L.14-2000,  
2 SECTION 43, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 143. (a) "Fund", for purposes of IC 16-26-2, has  
4 the meaning set forth in IC 16-26-2-2.

5 (b) "Fund", for purposes of IC 16-46-5, has the meaning set forth in  
6 IC 16-46-5-3.

7 **(c) "Fund", for purposes of IC 16-46-12, has the meaning set**  
8 **forth in IC 16-46-12-1.**

9 SECTION 2. IC 16-19-3-26, AS AMENDED BY P.L.131-2001,  
10 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
11 JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 26. (a) The anatomical gift promotion fund is  
12 established. The fund consists of amounts distributed to the fund by the  
13 auditor of state under IC 9-18-2-16.

14 (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not  
15 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same  
16 manner as other public funds are invested. Interest that accrues from  
17 these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

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1 (c) The state department shall administer the fund. Any expenses  
2 incurred in administering the fund shall be paid from the fund.

3 (d) Except as provided in subsections (e) and (f), the state  
4 department shall select appropriate organ procurement organizations  
5 to which the money deposited in the fund shall be distributed.

6 (e) Except as provided in subsection (f), the state department may  
7 not distribute any money from the fund after June 30, 2001.

8 (f) Beginning July 1, 2002, the state department shall distribute  
9 money deposited in the fund **as follows:**

10 **(1) For the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002:**

11 **(A) sixty thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$60,650) for**  
12 **payment to the Indiana Blood Center for testing of bone**  
13 **marrow before entrance into the National Bone Marrow**  
14 **Registry; and**

15 **(B) the lesser of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or the**  
16 **amount in the fund after the distribution is made under**  
17 **clause (A) shall be distributed to the bone marrow and**  
18 **organ donor fund established under IC 16-46-12-2.**

19 **After the distribution to the bone marrow and organ donor**  
20 **fund under this subdivision, any amount remaining in the**  
21 **fund shall be distributed to the Indiana Donation Alliance**  
22 **Foundation.**

23 **(2) For the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, the money**  
24 **in the fund shall be distributed to the Indiana Donation**  
25 **Alliance Foundation.**

26 (g) The Indiana Donation Alliance Foundation shall keep  
27 information regarding the identity of an individual who has indicated  
28 a desire to make an organ or tissue donation confidential.

29 (h) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert  
30 to the state general fund.

31 (i) This section expires June 30, 2004.

32 SECTION 3. IC 16-46-12 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
33 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
34 JULY 1, 2002]:

35 **Chapter 12. Bone Marrow and Organ Donations**

36 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "fund" refers to the bone**  
37 **marrow and organ donor fund established by section 2 of this**  
38 **chapter.**

39 **Sec. 2. (a) The bone marrow and organ donor fund is**  
40 **established for the purposes under section 3 of this chapter. The**  
41 **department shall administer the fund.**

42 **(b) Expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from**

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**money in the fund.**

**(c) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same manner as other public money may be invested.**

**Sec. 3. The department shall use money in the fund to:**

- (1) establish a program; or**
- (2) provide grants to programs;**

**to provide free human leukocyte antigen (HLA) testing, which is administered to place an individual on a national bone marrow donor registry and provide free testing to place an individual on a national human organ donor registry.**

**Sec. 4. The department may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to administer this chapter.**

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## HOUSE MOTION

Mr. Speaker: I move that House Bill 1049 be amended to read as follows:

Page 1, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 2. IC 16-19-3-26, AS AMENDED BY P.L.131-2001, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 26. (a) The anatomical gift promotion fund is established. The fund consists of amounts distributed to the fund by the auditor of state under IC 9-18-2-16.

(b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same manner as other public funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

(c) The state department shall administer the fund. Any expenses incurred in administering the fund shall be paid from the fund.

(d) Except as provided in subsections (e) and (f), the state department shall select appropriate organ procurement organizations to which the money deposited in the fund shall be distributed.

(e) Except as provided in subsection (f), the state department may not distribute any money from the fund after June 30, 2001.

(f) Beginning July 1, 2002, the state department shall distribute money deposited in the fund **as follows:**

**(1) For the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, the lesser of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or the amount in the fund shall be distributed to the bone marrow and organ donor fund established under IC 16-46-12-2. After the distribution to the bone marrow and organ donor fund under this subdivision, any amount remaining in the fund shall be distributed to the Indiana Donation Alliance Foundation.**

**(2) For the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, the money in the fund shall be distributed to the Indiana Donor Alliance Foundation.**

(g) The Indiana Donation Alliance Foundation shall keep information regarding the identity of an individual who has indicated a desire to make an organ or tissue donation confidential.

(h) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert to the state general fund.

(i) This section expires June 30, 2004."

Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
