DIGEST OF SB 466 (Updated February 19, 2002 4:59 PM - DI 47)

Citations Affected: IC 14-22.

Synopsis: Local regulation of shooting ranges. Repeals provision that excluded shooting ranges located in an area designated before January 2, 1958, as an "S" suburban residence district by a county zoning ordinance from the law permitting local units of government to regulate the location, use, operation, safety, and construction of a shooting range.

Effective: July 1, 2002.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2001 General Assembly.
