**IMPACT: Local**

**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) This bill requires uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage to include coverage for a loss regardless of whether the uninsured or underinsured motor vehicle is in motion at the time of the incident that causes the loss if a police report is provided to the insurer not more than 48 hours after the incident.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2002.
