Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that the duty to support a child at least 18 years of age may not be terminated on the grounds that the child: (1) has not recently attended and is not enrolled in a secondary or postsecondary school; and (2) is self-supporting or capable of being self-supporting through employment; if the child is absent from school or is not employed because the child is providing care for a physically disabled custodial adult.
