

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 240 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 3, after line 12 , begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 1. IC 4-33-7-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 3. A person may not receive a
4 supplier's license if:
5 (1) the person has been convicted of a felony under Indiana law,
6 the laws of any other state, or laws of the United States;
7 (2) the person has knowingly or intentionally submitted an
8 application for a license under this chapter that contains false
9 information;
10 (3) the person is a member of the commission;
11 (4) the person is an officer, a director, or a managerial employee
12 of a person described in subdivision (1) or (2);
13 (5) the person employs an individual who:
14 (A) is described in subdivision (1), (2), or (3); and
15 (B) participates in the management or operation of gambling
16 operations authorized under this article;
17 (6) the person owns more than a ten percent (10%) ownership
18 interest in any other person holding an owner's license issued
19 under this ~~chapter~~; **article**; or
20 (7) a license issued to the person:
21 (A) under this article; or
22 (B) to supply gaming supplies in another jurisdiction;
23 has been revoked.
24 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
