SENATE RESOLUTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the establishment of an interim study committee on education leadership.

Whereas, An integral factor in improving student achievement is school and district leadership;

Whereas, It takes quality executive school leaders to inspire and support teachers and to create the conditions necessary to change poor performing schools into high performers;

Whereas, The leadership of our schools currently does not represent the diversity of the state;

Whereas, Schools in this state report shrinking pools of qualified candidates willing to assume leadership roles as principals and superintendents;

Whereas, We must find ways to encourage leaders to take on high risk positions and to stay with those schools over time; and

Whereas, In order to retain quality leaders, especially in high risk schools and districts, conditions of professional practice must be aligned to promote exemplary performance of school leaders; roles and responsibilities, authority and accountability, and incentives and rewards are areas for study: Therefore,



*Be it resolved by the Senate of the
General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to establish a
2 committee to study education leadership.

3 SECTION 2. That the committee, if established, shall operate
4 under the direction of the legislative council and that the committee
5 shall issue a final report when directed to do so by the council.
