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A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION to memorialize and honor Dylan Sniegowski.

*Whereas, Dylan Sniegowski was born February 5, 1998;*

*Whereas, Dylan appeared to be a healthy baby boy until, at age one, he began having seizures;*

*Whereas, by the time doctors were able to diagnose the cause, Dylan's body had been ravaged by the seizures, leaving him wheelchair bound and entirely dependent;*

*Whereas, after enduring many surgeries to correct his rare metabolic disorder, on January 13, 2002, Dylan lost his battle and passed away;*

*Whereas, with proper newborn screening, Dylan's disorder could have been diagnosed before the disease was able to seize his body; and*

*Whereas, in light of their experience, Dylan and his parents were very active in supporting newborn screening legislation, testifying before both the Senate Health and Senate Finance Committees last year: Therefore,*



*Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly  
of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:*

1           SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly memorializes  
2 and honors Dylan Sniegowski for his courageous fight throughout his
