Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill reduces from 48 hours to 8 hours the time within which work-related deaths and disasters must be reported to the Commissioner of Labor. It reduces from five to three the number of persons who must be hospitalized in order for a work-related incident to be defined as a disaster.

Effective Date: July 1, 2003.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) There could be some cost associated with the increase in the receiving of reports of incidents which result in the hospitalization of three or more persons instead of five people. The increased cost could probably be absorbed in the agency's budget.
