**IMPACT:** State & Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill authorizes the display of green lights on a vehicle other than those that flash or revolve. It makes it a Class C infraction to display a flashing or revolving green light on a public or private motor vehicle other than one belonging to a certified emergency medical technician. The bill revises the restrictions and conditions for display of green lights on a privately owned vehicle belonging to a certified emergency medical technician.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2003.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:**

**Explanation of State Revenues:** This bill narrows the definition for which there would be a violation involving the display of green lights on a vehicle, the violation of which would be a Class C infraction. A minimal reduction in infraction judgements and court fees deposited into the state General Fund might occur.
