HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the Eagle Scouts and Louie D. Hamner and Mary Hamner who hold the record for the most Eagle Scouts in a single family in Indiana.

Whereas, being an Eagle Scout carries with it a special significance, not only in scouting but also as he enters higher education, business or industry, and community service;

Whereas, not every boy who joins a Boy Scout troop earns the Eagle Scout rank, only about four percent of all Boy Scouts do so. This represents more than one million Boy Scouts who have earned that rank since 1911;

Whereas, being given the award to be an Eagle Scout is performance-based achievement whose standards have been well-maintained over the years;

Whereas, Louie D. Hamner, Jr. and Mary Hamner hold the record for the most Eagle Scouts in a single family in Indiana. The Hamner's eight sons and seven of their grandsons are Eagle Scouts;

Whereas, Lance Hamner, Sterling Hamner, Austin Hamner, Matthew Hamner, Mark Hamner, Jared Hamner, Louie Hamner, III and Spencer Hamner, all sons who earned the rank of being an Eagle Scout;

Whereas, Lance Hamner, Jr., John Hamner, Nicholas Hamner, Nathan Hamner, Alexander Hamner and Peter Ketchum, all grandsons who earned the rank of being an Eagle Scout;

Whereas, a Life Scout is the fifth and last rank before Eagle
