A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003] (a) There is
- 2 appropriated to Indiana University fifteen million dollars
- 3 (\$15,000,000) from the state general fund for its use in developing
- 4 I-Light 2 for the period beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30,
- 5 2005.
- 6 (b) I-Light 2 will provide an optical fiber infrastructure to link
- 7 the following general areas to the original I-Light:
- 8 (1) Gary/Hammond;
- 9 (2) South Bend;
- 10 (3) Fort Wayne;
- 11 (4) Kokomo;
- 12 (5) Muncie/Anderson;
- 13 (6) Richmond;
- 14 (7) Terre Haute;
- 15 (8) Columbus;
- 16 (9) Vincennes;
- 17 (10) New Albany; and
- 18 (11) Evansville.
