DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-2-5-5.2.

Synopsis: Criminal history checks. Requires the Indiana central repository for criminal history information to process a request for a national criminal history check from the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Crime Information Center at the request of a governmental body concerning an applicant for employment with the governmental body in certain positions.

Effective: July 1, 2003.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-2-5-5.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 2003]: **Sec. 5.2. (a) As used in this section, "governmental body"**
- 4 **means an agency, a board, a branch, a bureau, a commission, a**
- 5 **council, a department, an institution, an office, or another**
- 6 **establishment of any of the following:**
- 7 (1) **The state.**
- 8 (2) **A political subdivision (as defined in IC 36-1-2-13).**
- 9 (3) **An entity established by the general assembly as a body**
- 10 **corporate and politic.**
- 11 (b) **As used in this section, "sensitive employment" means**
- 12 **employment by a governmental body involving any of the**
- 13 **following:**
- 14 (1) **Handling, accounting for, or having the authority to**
- 15 **determine the disposition of money under the control of the**
- 16 **governmental body.**
- 17 (2) **Access to:**



- 1 **(A) confidential information; or**
- 2 **(B) information relating to the identity or financial affairs**
- 3 **of individuals;**
- 4 **in the possession of the governmental body.**
- 5 **(c) The Indiana central repository for criminal history**
- 6 **information shall process a request for a national criminal history**
- 7 **check from the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Crime**
- 8 **Information Center at the request of a governmental body**
- 9 **concerning an applicant for employment with the governmental**
- 10 **body in sensitive employment.**
- 11 **(d) The Indiana central repository for criminal history**
- 12 **information shall provide the results of the national criminal**
- 13 **history check only to the governmental body making the request.**

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
