SENATE BILL No. 335

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state and local administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated to the Indiana economic development partnership**
3 **fund twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) from the state general**
4 **fund to fund grants to be made from the Indiana economic**
5 **development partnership fund for the period beginning July 1,**
6 **2003, and ending June 30, 2005.**

7 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2005.**
