**Synopsis:** Abstinence instruction. Requires instruction on maintaining self-control, resisting peer pressure, and establishing positive relationships in preparation for marriage throughout school instruction on human sexuality and sexually transmitted diseases.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-10.1-4-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 11. Throughout
- 3 instruction on human sexuality or sexually transmitted diseases, an
- 4 accredited school shall:
- 5 (1) teach abstinence from sexual activity outside of marriage as
- 6 the expected standard for all school age children;
- 7 (2) include that abstinence from sexual activity is the only certain
- 8 way to avoid out-of-wedlock pregnancy, sexually transmitted
- 9 diseases, and other associated health problems; ~~and~~
- 10 (3) include that the best way to avoid sexually transmitted
- 11 diseases and other associated health problems is to establish a
- 12 mutually faithful monogamous relationship in the context of
- 13 marriage; **and**
- 14 (4) **include instruction on maintaining self-control, resisting**
- 15 **peer pressure, and establishing positive relationships in**
- 16 **preparation for marriage.**
