DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-10.2-5-5.

Synopsis: School performance. Provides that a school may not be placed in the lowest performance category or be sanctioned for poor performance until the school has received adequate funding to fully carry out the school's improvement and achievement plan for at least three consecutive years.

Effective: July 1, 2003.

HOUSE BILL No. 1478



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-10.2-5-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 3 1, 2003]: **Sec. 5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this chapter or**
 4 **IC 20-10.2-6:**
 5 (1) a school may not be placed in the lowest category or
 6 designation; and
 7 (2) the consequences set forth in IC 20-10.2-6 may not be
 8 carried out;
 9 until the school has received adequate funding to fully carry out
 10 the school's strategic and continuous school improvement and
 11 achievement plan developed under IC 20-10.2-3 for at least three
 12 (3) consecutive years.
