HOUSE BILL No. 1921



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 14-22-31-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 3. **(a)** A shooting
3 preserve may not be established within a distance of five (5) miles of
4 a state owned game refuge or state public hunting ground.

5 **(b)** Duck shooting ~~may on a shooting preserve~~ **is not be** permitted
6 if wild ~~duck~~, **ducks**, geese, or other migratory game birds frequent the
7 area where the captive reared and properly marked mallard ducks are
8 to be held, released, and flighted for shooting.

9 **(c)** ~~This subsection does not apply to game birds and waterfowl~~
10 **at shooting preserves. A person may not kill or wound a wild**
11 **animal with a firearm or deadly weapon if the animal is tied,**
12 **staked out, caged, or intentionally confined in a man-made**
13 **enclosure, regardless of the size of the enclosure.**

14 **(d)** A person, including an owner, agent, employee, participant,
15 and spectator, may not:

- 16 **(1)** instigate, promote, aid, or abet; or
17 **(2)** profit from or intentionally maintain or allow a place to be

2 **an activity prohibited in subsection (c).**
