DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Great lakes protection fund. Appropriates to the great lakes protection fund \$5,000,000 for the 2003-2004 state fiscal year and \$5,000,000 for the 2004-2005 state fiscal year to fund pledges made by the state. Prohibits the budget agency from allotting money to the great lakes protection fund until the state becomes a party to the great lakes protection fund agreement of 1989.

Effective: July 1, 2003.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning environmental law and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003] (a) There is
- 2 appropriated to the great lakes protection fund, as established by
- 3 the Great Lakes Protection Fund Agreement of 1989, five million
- 4 dollars (\$5,000,000) from the state general fund beginning July 1,
- 5 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.
- 6 (b) There is appropriated to the great lakes protection fund, as
- 7 established by the Great Lakes Protection Fund Agreement of
- 8 1989, five million dollars (\$5,000,000) from the state general fund
- 9 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005.
- 10 (c) The money appropriated under this SECTION shall be used
- 11 to fund pledges made by the state to the great lakes protection
- 12 fund. However, the budget agency may not allocate money to the
- 13 great lakes protection fund under this SECTION until the state
- 14 becomes a party to the Great Lakes Protection Fund Agreement of
- 15 1989.
- 16 (d) This SECTION expires July 1, 2005.
