

# SENATE MOTION

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1353 be amended to read as follows:

1           Page 2, delete lines 23 through 27, begin a new line block indented  
2           and insert:

3           **"(1) be published:**  
4                 **(A) one (1) time in accordance with IC 5-3-1; and**  
5                 **(B) not later than thirty (30) days after the ordinance is**  
6                 **adopted by the legislative body in accordance with**  
7                 **IC 5-3-1; and**  
8                 **(2) delay the implementation of the fee increase for ninety (90)**  
9                 **days after the date the ordinance is published under**  
10                **subdivision (1)."**

11           Page 3, delete lines 20 through 24, begin a new line block indented  
12           and insert:

13           **"(1) be published:**  
14                 **(A) one (1) time in accordance with IC 5-3-1; and**  
15                 **(B) not later than thirty (30) days after the ordinance is**  
16                 **adopted by the legislative body in accordance with**  
17                 **IC 5-3-1; and**  
18                 **(2) delay the implementation of the fee increase for ninety (90)**  
19                 **days after the date the ordinance is published under**  
20                 **subdivision (1)."**

21           Page 4, delete lines 4 through 8, begin a new line block indented  
22           and insert:

23           **"(1) be published:**  
24                 **(A) one (1) time in accordance with IC 5-3-1; and**  
25                 **(B) not later than thirty (30) days after the ordinance is**  
26                 **adopted by the legislative body in accordance with**  
27                 **IC 5-3-1; and**  
28                 **(2) delay the implementation of the fee increase for ninety (90)**  
29                 **days after the date the ordinance is published under**  
30                 **subdivision (1)."**
