SENATE BILL No. 433

DIGEST OF SB 433 (Updated February 25, 2003 2:01 PM - DI 106)

Citations Affected: IC 25-34.1.

Synopsis: Appraisal fraud funding. Requires the real estate appraiser licensure and certification board to recommend a new fee to be imposed upon licensed or certified appraisers to fund the investigation of real estate or appraisal fraud. Establishes the investigative fund, to be jointly administered by the attorney general and the professional licensing board.

Effective: July 1, 2003.

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SENATE BILL No. 433



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 25-34.1-2-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 6. **(a) Except as**
3 **provided in subsection (b)**, all funds collected under this article shall,
4 at the end of each month, be reported to the auditor of state and
5 deposited with the treasurer of state for deposit in the general fund. All
6 expenses incurred in the administration of this article shall be paid
7 from the general fund.

8 **(b) The commission shall establish a fee for real estate brokers**
9 **and salespersons to provide funds for the purpose of investigating**
10 **and taking enforcement action against real estate fraud and real**
11 **estate appraisal fraud under this article. All funds collected under**
12 **this subsection shall be deposited in the investigative fund**
13 **established by IC 25-34.1-8-7.5.**

14 SECTION 2. IC 25-34.1-3-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
15 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 9. (a) The commission
16 shall establish fees under IC 25-1-8-2 to implement section 8 of this
17 chapter **and to provide funding for the investigative fund**

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1 **established by IC 25-34.1-8-7.5.**

2 (b) Notwithstanding IC 25-1-8-2, a fee described in subsection (a)
3 may not be less than fifty dollars (\$50).

4 (c) The board may collect a fee required by federal law and transmit
5 the fees to the federal government as required by federal law.

6 (d) A fee described in subsection (a) is in addition to any fees
7 required by federal law.

8 SECTION 3. IC 25-34.1-8-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
9 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 6. The board shall
10 submit recommendations to the commission concerning the following:

11 (1) Implementation and operation of the real estate appraiser
12 licensure and certification program under IC 25-34.1-3-8.

13 (2) Rules governing real estate appraisers licensed and certified
14 under IC 25-34.1-3-8.

15 **(3) Establishing a fee in an amount necessary to fund the
16 investigative fund established by section 7.5 of this chapter.**

17 **(4) Rules governing the administration of the investigative
18 fund established by section 7.5 of this chapter.**

19 SECTION 4. IC 25-34.1-8-7.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
20 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
21 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 7.5. **(a) The investigative fund is
22 established to provide funds for investigating and taking
23 enforcement action against real estate fraud. The fund shall be
24 administered by the attorney general and the professional licensing
25 agency.**

26 **(b) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from
27 the money in the fund. The fund consists of money from a fee
28 imposed upon licensed or certified appraisers and real estate
29 brokers and salespersons under IC 25-34.1-2-6 and IC 25-34.1-3-9.**

30 **(c) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
31 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
32 manner as other public money may be invested.**

33 **(d) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not
34 revert to the state general fund. If the total amount in the
35 investigative fund exceeds five hundred thousand dollars
36 (\$500,000) at the end of a state fiscal year after payment of all
37 claims and expenses, the amount that exceeds five hundred
38 thousand dollars (\$500,000) reverts to the state general fund.**

39 **(e) Money in the fund is continually appropriated for use by the
40 attorney general and the professional licensing agency to conduct
41 investigations and take enforcement action against real estate and
42 appraisal fraud under this article. The attorney general and the**



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1 professional licensing agency shall divide the money in the fund
2 equally.

3 SECTION 5. IC 25-34.1-8-15 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
4 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: **Sec. 15. The office of the attorney**
6 **general and the professional licensing agency may use the**
7 **investigative fund established by section 7.5 of this chapter to hire**
8 **investigators and other employees to investigate and prosecute real**
9 **estate fraud and real estate appraisal fraud.**

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COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. President: The Senate Committee on Criminal, Civil and Public Policy, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 433, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 25-34.1-2-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 6. **(a) Except as provided in subsection (b)**, all funds collected under this article shall, at the end of each month, be reported to the auditor of state and deposited with the treasurer of state for deposit in the general fund. All expenses incurred in the administration of this article shall be paid from the general fund.

(b) The commission shall establish a fee for real estate brokers and salespersons to provide funds for the purpose of investigating and taking enforcement action against real estate fraud and real estate appraisal fraud under this article. All funds collected under this subsection shall be deposited in the investigative fund established by IC 25-34.1-8-7.5."

Page 2, line 2, delete "an annual" and insert "a".

Page 2, line 9, after "is" insert **"established to provide funds for investigating and taking enforcement action against real estate fraud. The fund shall be administered by the attorney general and the professional licensing agency."**

Page 2, delete lines 10 through 11.

Page 2, line 13, delete "an annual" and insert "a".

Page 2, line 14, delete "educational" and insert **"real estate brokers and salespersons under IC 25-34.1-2-6 and IC 25-34.1-3-9."**

Page 2, delete line 15.

Page 2, line 26, after "general" insert **"and the professional licensing agency"**.

Page 2, line 26, delete "of" and insert **"and take enforcement action against real estate and"**.

Page 2, line 27, delete "chapter." and insert **"article. The attorney general and the professional licensing agency shall divide the money in the fund equally."**

Page 2, line 31, after "general" insert **"and the professional licensing agency"**.

Page 2, line 32, delete "employees, approved by" and insert

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"employees".

Page 2, line 33, delete "the board,".

Page 2, line 33, insert after "estate" insert "**fraud and real estate**".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
