A HOUSE RESOLUTION to honor the services of Jason Hartman to the House of Representatives upon his leaving to take office as Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Bainbridge.

Whereas, Jason Hartman will resign from the Indiana House of Representatives in December of this year due to his election as Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Bainbridge on November 4, 2003; and

Whereas, Jason has served as the Postmaster and Facilities Manager for the House of Representatives since 1996; and

Whereas, Jason has served as the Reading Clerk for the past eight years under both former Speaker John R. Gregg and current Speaker B. Patrick Bauer; and



Whereas, Jason has been active in Putnam County politics since 1991 when he first became a Democratic Precinct Committeeman for the Monroe East Precinct; and

Whereas, Jason was at one time the youngest Democratic County Chairman in the state, having been elected at the age of 23 in 1994 and serving until 1996; and

Whereas, Jason was a founding member of the Board of Trustees of the Walnut Creek Fire Protection District in Bainbridge, Indiana; and

Whereas, Jason became the President and Co-founder of Sound Investment Productions, Inc., a professional disc-jockey business, in 1993; and

Whereas, Jason became the President and Co-founder of Sound Investment Amusements, a coin-operated amusement business, in the Spring of 2003; and

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the
