HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the Bishop Chatard High School football team.

Whereas, The Bishop Chatard High School football team has a perfect 7 - 0 record in the state championships;

Whereas, The November 29, 2003, 49-0 victory in the Class 3A state football championship marks the third consecutive year that the Trojans have been victorious in the state championships;

Whereas, During the 2003 championship game, running back Dray Mason set five individual 3A records, and the team set 13 records, including most points in a quarter, most total points, and greatest margin of victory;

Whereas, In the three consecutive title years, the Trojans amassed a 40-5 record that included a perfect 15-0 season in 2002;

Whereas, With the victory in their seventh state football championship title game, the Trojans move into a tie with Ben Davis High School and Roncalli High School for the most football championships in state history;

Whereas, The Trojans also became the first Class 3A school and the third school in state finals football history to win three consecutive state championships;



Whereas, The Trojans have won five of their seven state titles in Class 3A. The other two victories (1983 and 1984) were in Class 2A; and

Whereas, Excellence such as that displayed by the Chatard Trojans deserves special recognition: Therefore,

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives

the Senate concurring:*

1 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly congratulates the
2 Chatard High School Trojans on their Class 3A football victory and
3 wishes them continued success in the future, both on and off the
