SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Legislative Council to assign an interim or statutory committee to study the crime victim laws of Indiana.

Whereas, the State of Indiana seeks to preserve and defend the rights of crime victims;

Whereas, such rights are protected by constitutional provisions, statutes, and programs;

Whereas, the General Assembly wants to insure that victims of crime are being adequately served; and

Whereas, a legislative committee should review Indiana's constitutional and statutory provisions, and determine whether programs are being properly implemented across the State to adequately serve victims of crime: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:

1 SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign an
2 interim or statutory committee to study laws concerning the rights of
