**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) This bill provides that volunteers and volunteer directors of: (1) certain community mental retardation and other developmental disabilities centers; (2) certain rehabilitation centers; and (3) nonprofit organizations; are immune from civil liability arising from the performance of the duties of the volunteer or volunteer director if the volunteer or volunteer director exercises reasonable care in the performance of those duties.
