## SENATE BILL No. 355

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning gaming.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-33-6-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2005]: **Sec. 22. (a) As used in this section, "corporate**  
4 **headquarters" refers to a domestic business entity's physical**  
5 **presence in Indiana that results in Indiana being the regular**  
6 **principal place of business of the business entity's chief executive,**  
7 **operating, and financial officers.**  
8 (b) A licensed owner or operating agent shall locate the licensed  
9 owner's or operating agent's corporate headquarters in Indiana  
10 before June 30, 2006.
