

SENATE BILL No. 358

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Retired state police officer health coverage. Provides a three month period during which a retired state police officer who previously participated in health coverage provided for retired state police officers and allowed the coverage to lapse may reenroll in the coverage.

Effective: July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005] (a) A retired state
- 2 **police officer who:**
- 3 **(1) participated in health coverage provided for retired state**
- 4 **police officers under IC 5-10-8-6 or IC 5-10-8-8 after**
- 5 **retirement;**
- 6 **(2) allowed the health coverage to lapse; and**
- 7 **(3) is not participating in the health coverage on July 1, 2005;**
- 8 **may reenroll in the health coverage after June 30, 2005, and before**
- 9 **October 1, 2005.**
- 10 **(b) A retired state police officer who reenrolls in health**
- 11 **coverage under subsection (a) is subject to the same terms and**
- 12 **conditions of coverage that would apply to the retired state police**
- 13 **officer if the retired state police officer had not allowed the health**
- 14 **coverage to lapse.**
- 15 **(c) This SECTION expires July 1, 2006.**
