DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 22-5-4.

Synopsis: Use of tobacco by an off duty employee. Repeals the prohibition against an employer: (1) prohibiting an employee's off duty use of tobacco; or (2) discriminating against an employee with respect to compensation, benefits, or terms and conditions of employment based on an employee's off duty use of tobacco.

Effective: July 1, 2005.
