# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 270 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 29, after line 30, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 55. [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2006
- 3 (RETROACTIVE)] (a) As used in this SECTION, "office" refers to
- 4 the office of the secretary of family and social services.
- 5 (b) As used in this SECTION, "recipient" means a person who
- 6 has received or is receiving medical assistance for the person or
- 7 another person under any of the following:
- 8 (1) IC 12-10-10 (Community and home options to
- 9 institutional care for the elderly and disabled program).
- 10 (2) IC 12-15 (Medicaid).
- 11 (3) IC 12-17.6 (Children's health insurance program).
- 12 (4) Any other program providing health care or hospital
- 13 benefits that are administered by the state.
- 14 (c) Not later than October 1 each year, the office shall submit
- 15 to the legislative council a report listing each employer in Indiana
- 16 that is identified as the employer of a total of at least one hundred
- 17 (100) persons who are:
- 18 (1) recipients; or
- 19 (2) persons identified as responsible for providing any
- 20 portion of a recipient's support.
- 21 (d) The report required by subsection (c) must include at least
- 22 the following information for each employer:
- 23 (1) The name of the employer, and the name of every
- 24 subsidiary or franchise of the employer that employed at

- 1           **least one (1) recipient or person who was responsible for**  
2           **providing any portion of a recipient's support.**  
3           **(2) The address of each location of the employer where at**  
4           **least one (1) recipient or person who was responsible for**  
5           **providing any portion of a recipient's support was employed.**  
6           **(3) For each program of medical assistance, the number of**  
7           **recipients who were:**  
8                 **(A) employees; or**  
9                 **(B) children or other dependents who identified an**  
10                **employee as responsible for providing any portion of the**  
11                **recipient's support.**  
12           **(4) The total cost to the state of the medical assistance**  
13           **provided to the recipients described in subdivision (3).**  
14           **(e) The report must be submitted in an electronic format under**  
15           **IC 5-14-6.**  
16           **(f) The report:**  
17                 **(1) may not disclose any information from which the identity**  
18                 **of an individual recipient may be ascertained; and**  
19                 **(2) is subject to:**  
20                         **(A) the privacy standards established under the federal**  
21                         **Medicaid regulations; and**  
22                         **(B) the confidentiality provisions of the federal Health**  
23                         **Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996**  
24                         **(P.L. 104-191).**  
25           **(g) A report submitted under this section is a public record**  
26           **subject to public inspection under IC 5-14-3. The office of the**  
27           **secretary shall make the reports submitted under this section**  
28           **available to the public through all appropriate means, including the**  
29           **Internet.**  
30           **SECTION 56. An emergency is declared for this act."**
