IMPACT: State & Local

Summary of Legislation: This bill requires contractors and subcontractors on public works projects to certify each week certain information relating to the wages paid to the workers on the project.

Effective Date: July 1, 2007.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) The bill requires a contractor or subcontractor to file weekly reports with the agency awarding the contract. The report must include a certified payroll that includes the following information for each worker:

1. Name.
2. Address.
3. Labor classification.
4. Wage rate paid.
5. The daily and weekly number of hours worked.
6. Deductions made from wages paid.
7. Actual wages paid.

The report can be submitted on paper or in electronic form. The Department of Labor is responsible for developing the format and style of the report. The Department of Labor could incur some additional expense in developing the report, and agencies could have some additional expense if the reports have to be reviewed and retained.
