Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that if: (1) a state employee requests arbitration concerning a decision rendered by the State Employee Appeals Commission; and (2) a party to the arbitration fails to strike a name from the list of arbitrators provided by the Commissioner of Labor within 15 days after receipt of that list; the Commissioner shall strike a name on behalf of that party.
