

SENATE BILL No. 317

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-18-2-160.5; IC 16-41-42; IC 25-1-7-1.

Synopsis: Health care services by out-of-state entities. Requires the state department of health to issue registrations and maintain a registry for out-of-state mobile health care entities. Requires out-of-state mobile health care entities to register with the state department before doing business in Indiana.

Effective: July 1, 2007.

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SENATE BILL No. 317



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-18-2-160.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007]: **Sec. 160.5. "Health care entity", for**
4 **purposes of IC 16-41-42, has the meaning set forth in**
5 **IC 16-41-42-1.**

6 SECTION 2. IC 16-41-42 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
7 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
8 JULY 1, 2007]:

9 **Chapter 42. Registration of Out-of-State Mobile Health Care**
10 **Entities**

11 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "health care entity" means an**
12 **entity that is:**

- 13 (1) **registered or licensed as a health care entity under the**
14 **laws of another state, a foreign country, or a province in a**
15 **foreign country; and**
- 16 (2) **provides health care services, including the performance**
17 **of health care tests, in a mobile facility.**



1 **Sec. 2.** The state department shall maintain a registry of health
2 care entities that apply for and meet the registration requirements
3 under this chapter.
4 **Sec. 3.** The registry must include the name of each registered
5 health care entity and the date that the health care entity
6 registered with the state department under this chapter.
7 **Sec. 4.** The state department shall issue a certificate of
8 registration to a health care entity that applies for registration and
9 meets the requirements of this chapter.
10 **Sec. 5.** A health care entity applying for registration under this
11 chapter shall disclose the following:
12 (1) The types of health care services that the health care entity
13 is going to provide in Indiana.
14 (2) The names of any employees who are currently in good
15 standing licensed, certified, or registered in a health care
16 profession in:
17 (A) Indiana; or
18 (B) any other state;
19 and a copy of the employee's license, certification, or
20 registration.
21 (3) Any health care services that are to be provided under a
22 contract between the health care entity and a licensed,
23 certified, or registered Indiana health care person.
24 (4) The types of:
25 (A) health care services;
26 (B) health care tests; and
27 (C) equipment;
28 that the health care entity is going to perform or use.
29 **Sec. 6.** A registered health care entity shall display the entity's
30 certificate of registration in a conspicuous place in sight of a
31 consumer of the health care entity.
32 **Sec. 7.** A certificate of registration expires one (1) calendar year
33 after its issuance.
34 **Sec. 8.** A health care entity may not provide services in Indiana
35 until the health care entity is registered under this chapter with the
36 state department.
37 **Sec. 9.** Registration under this chapter does not exempt a health
38 care entity from the licensure, certification, and registration
39 requirements of IC 25.
40 **Sec. 10.** The state department shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2,
41 including rules specifying registration renewal procedures,
42 necessary to implement this chapter.

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1 SECTION 3. IC 25-1-7-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007]: Sec. 1. As used in this chapter:

3 "Board" means the appropriate agency listed in the definition of
4 regulated occupation in this section.

5 "Director" refers to the director of the division of consumer
6 protection.

7 "Division" refers to the division of consumer protection, office of
8 the attorney general.

9 "Licensee" means a person who is:

10 (1) licensed, certified, or registered by a board listed in this
11 section; and

12 (2) the subject of a complaint filed with the division.

13 "Person" means an individual, a partnership, a limited liability
14 company, or a corporation.

15 "Regulated occupation" means an occupation in which a person is
16 licensed, certified, or registered by one (1) of the following:

17 (1) Indiana board of accountancy (IC 25-2.1-2-1).

18 (2) Board of registration for architects and landscape architects
19 (IC 25-4-1-2).

20 (3) Indiana auctioneer commission (IC 25-6.1-2-1).
